We were appointed by Bombardier Derby on a design and build basis, to undertake car park construction works at their Litchurch Lane depot.

The new car park was extended into an abandoned electricity substation located on the depot, and works included partial demolition of foundations and structures.

A new drainage system incorporating Gatic channels was installed to alleviate ponding over the extensive, newly created hard standing area.

We constructed all pedestrian walkways in and out of the car park and created a new entrance involving pedestrian

barriers, tarmac walkways and all associated white lining. A new flood light system was also installed including concrete bases and all associated ducting.

Despite the sites busy location in close proximity to the extensive assembly sheds, which remained open for the duration of this scheme, all works were handed over with minimal disruption as a direct result of our continued liaison with Bombardier employees.

All works were undertaken by our directly employed personnel in a safe, efficient manner and to a high quality standard; we have since been awarded further contracts by Bombardier based on our works.
