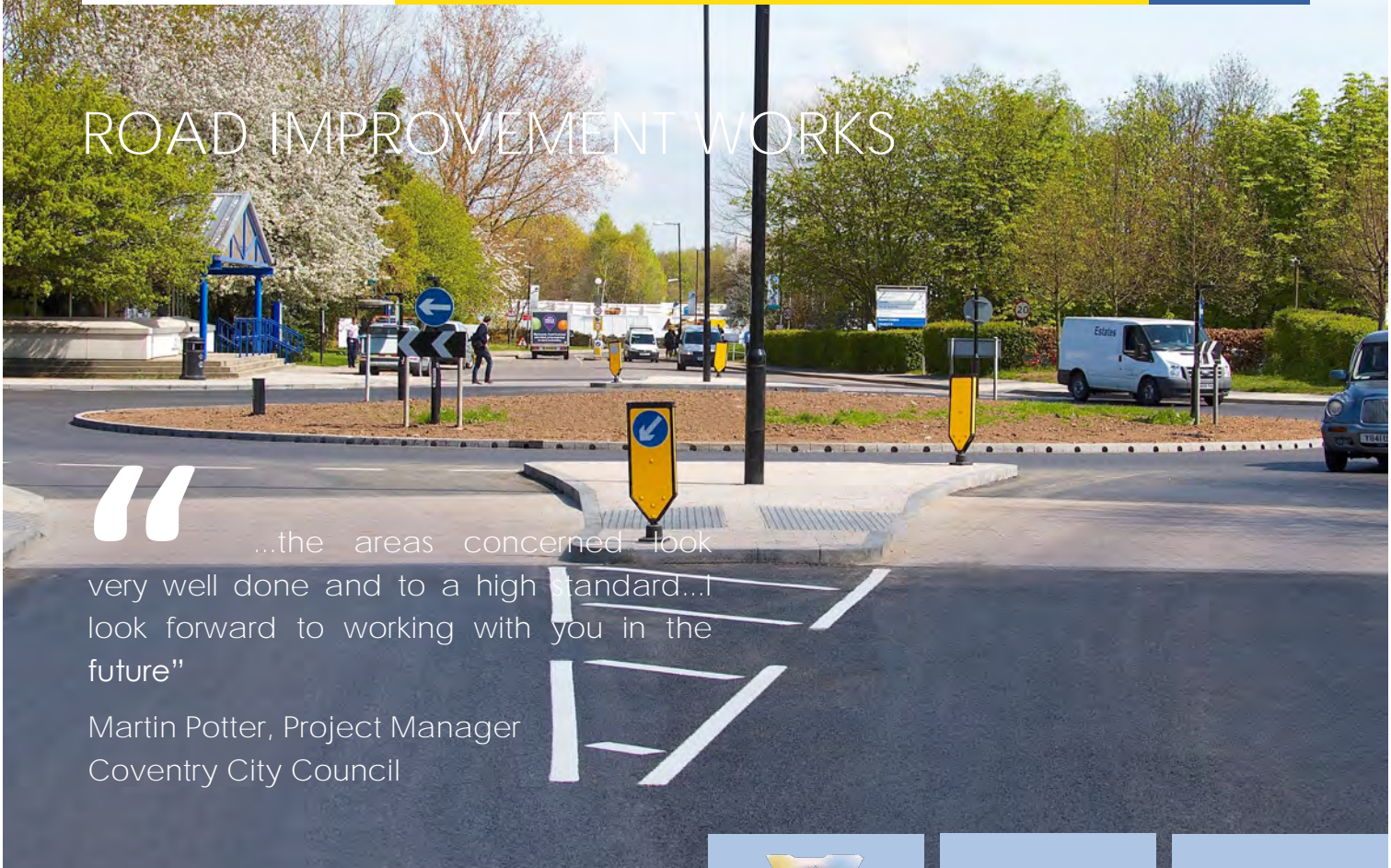

We were appointed to undertake Gibbert Hill Road and Scarman Roundabout improvement works within Warwick University Campus.

Works involved the upgrade of one of the main entrances into the University campus, and the addition of bus lay-bys and shelters.

Work on Scarman Roundabout included extensive service alterations and the creation of four granite crossings with central islands to support multiple pedestrians and cyclists.

The island approach lanes were narrowed to slow oncoming traffic. We also created two new bus laybys on the island

approaches, conducted extensive resurfacing of roads & footpaths, and installed concrete and granite kerbing.

Due to the works proximity to Warwick University during exam period, extensive traffic management was undertaken and agreed prior to works commencing. This included heavy duty traffic barriers, multiple diversions and road closures, minimising disruption and noise to all affected parties.

All works were undertaken by our directly employed, highly trained personnel in a safe, efficient manner and to a high-quality standard, completed ahead of schedule in a very short timeframe.
